Our Mexico Week of Rivers trip offers an action packed exploration of Mexico's finest rivers. Situated on the banks of the Rio Antigua, the small rural village of Jalcomulco, Veracruz, is our gateway to over 100km of **continuous whitewater**. The spectacular Barranca-Grande and Pescados sections of this river offer remote, steep and technical whitewater, imposing canyon walls and lush tropical greenery. Our final river is the Tomata. Test you vertical limits by launching yourself over a series of 5m to 7m waterfalls! **Challenging, active, fun and adventurous...** the Mexico Week of Rivers oc1 week makes for an awesome winter whitewater escape.

ITINERARY:

- Day 1: Arrive Veracruz and transfer to Jalcomulco
- Day 2: Tour town and Paddling the Antigua River
- Day 3: Paddling the Actopan River
- Day 4: Barranca Grande - Paddle to Amititla
- Day 5: Barranca Grande - Paddle to Monte Blanco
- Day 6: Barranca Grande - Paddle the Pescados
- Day 7: Creeking on the Tomata River
- Day 8: Departure
